Welcome to the seventh edition of our newsletter update which we continue to produce and issue regularly to ensure you are kept informed and updated about the works that are being undertaken at the Grays Inn Road Development as they progress. In addition, periodic and timely information notices will be issued when necessary.

Recent, completed and ongoing activities

- All scaffold erections are now complete, inclusive of the oversail scaffolds.
- Monarflex has been installed to all elevations encapsulating the building.
- Localised construction of the permanent UK Power Networks single substation on Gray's Inn Road is now complete.
- Scaffold access stair installations are now complete.
- Demolition at the roof level is progressing well and is near completion.
- Removal of the bushes and shrubs from the courtyard area/quiet gardens is complete. These works were carried out with an ecologist in attendance under a watching brief.

• Discussion with London borough of Camden around the proposed pit lane in Clerkenwell Road is ongoing following consultation.

What's next?

Works and activities in the next 2 months:

- Continuation of the ongoing demolition activities.
- Scaffold dismantles as the demolition works progress.
- Scaffold erection works to the low-level building at the rear of 127 Clerkenwell Road (within Quiet Gardens).
- Disconnection of the Clerkenwell Road substation (subject to local authority approvals and managed by UK Power Networks).
- UK Power Networks are expected to commence their works on the single substation by Grays Inn Road in Q2-Q3 of this year following completed demolition of the building.
- Thames Water: water supply disconnections (subject to local authority approvals and managed by Thames Water).
